ORDINANCE NO. 22107

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND CORRECTING ORDINANCE NO. 21979, PASSED AND APPROVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TULSA, OKLAHOMA, ON THE 18TH DAY OF DECEMBER, 2008, AND APPROVED BY THE MAYOR PRO-TEM, ON THE 23RD DAY OF DECEMBER, 2008, WHICH CONTAINED A SCRIVENER'S ERROR; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 21979, passed and approved by the City Council on the 18th day of December, 2008, and approved by the Mayor Pro-Tem on the 23rd day of December, 2008, contained a scrivener's error; and

WHEREAS, said Ordinance No. 21979 should be amended to correct said error.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF TULSA:

Section 1. That Title 2, Chapter 1, paragraph 101.A.2, Tulsa Revised Ordinances, as contained in Section 1 of Ordinance No. 21979, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

"2. Fail to prevent any dog or cat owned, possessed, kept or harbored by him from running or being at large, whether such dog or cat is licensed or unlicensed; provided, however, that it shall be permissible:

- a. for a dog to be led off the premises of its owner when under leash or obediently at heel;
- b. for a police dog not to be under leash or obediently at heel while being utilized as a police dog in the performance of police duties and when accompanied by a police officer; or
- c. for a dog to not be under leash within an Off-Leash Park Area designated by the Park and Recreation Board of the City of Tulsa."

Section 2. REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith be and the same are now expressly repealed.

Section 3. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. That an emergency is now declared to exist for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, by reason whereof this ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its adoption, approval, and publication.

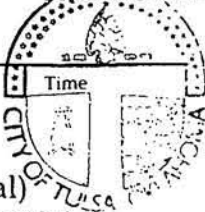
